Placements will receive training in bungee-assisted dance technique, which will be tailored to each individual's needs on the following dates: 7th, 9th, 11th, 21st, 22nd, 29th, 30th, 31st of August and 1st of September.

After this, we will offer a paid placement and performance opportunity to one female performer. This placement will involve bungee-assisted dance training, creative use of bungee-assisted dance and the learning of existing repertory. This placement will progress to professional paid work which involves performing with the cast of our latest production, **Me vs Me** in a tour of the North West.

This position would be ideal for someone based in or around the North West region.

Please send us two short films (a smart phone video is ideal):

- 1 x 30 second film of you dancing. We are looking for performers who move easily from a low position on the ground to standing; think deep pliés and elevated jumps; Capoeira and the fundamentals of contact improvisation when showing us how you move.
- 1 x short film of you explaining why you would like to work with Wired Aerial Theatre, where you are based and where you heard about the opportunity.

If you would like, you can also send us a short video (no longer than 60 seconds) which shows examples of you performing. This is not a requirement.

Closing date to receive applications is Friday 4th at 2pm. Successful applicants receive a phone message later that evening, inviting them to audition.
