Pre show workshop explores emotions and mental health through creative exercises/tasks and talks about images created within the show which could suggest or symbolise an emotional response.

Post show workshop uses fun activities to explore the **five ways to wellbeing** as a strategy to manage personal mental health.

There is also a **teachers' inset session** which can be delivered to dance, drama, health and wellbeing and pastoral departments, offering a holistic approach to allow the whole school to access the ideas explored in the workshops.
